CESA 3 is excited to celebrate the 31st Annual Champion Games on Friday, May 9th, at the Boscobel High School track! PLEASE SHARE THIS INFORMATION WITH ALL SPECIAL EDUCATION TEACHERS WITHIN YOUR DISTRICT. The rain date is set for Monday, May 12th.

Attending the Champion Games will give your students a unique opportunity to compete in track events, various field events, wheelchair races, and other fun activities.\* We also encourage schools to bring a general education peer for each student to promote an inclusive setting.

The Games will begin around **9:30 a.m.** and will conclude after the relay races at approximately **1:00 p.m.** There is no cost to attend, and a free morning snack (**Capri Sun juice and a Rice Krispie treat**) will be provided. **Lunch will not be provided—please plan accordingly.** Each school is responsible for transportation and appropriate chaperones throughout the event.

Each school attending the Champion Games MUST submit attendance numbers by Friday, April 25th. It is crucial that we receive an accurate count of students and chaperones to ensure we have enough snacks and awards. See the next page for registration instructions.

# **CESA 3 Champion Games - Notes & Reminders**

#### **CANCELLATIONS/POSTPONEMENTS:**

- If you have any questions regarding the weather, contact Jim Nelson at (608) 778-1997.
- The rain date is set for Monday, May 12.
- DO NOT CALL BOSCOBEL HIGH SCHOOL

#### TRANSPORTATION/PARKING:

- All buses **must park** where designated upon arrival.
- Buses are not permitted to unload or park at Boscobel High School.

#### **REGISTRATION/OPENING CEREMONY:**

- Each school will receive a **packet** at the check-in booth.
- Turn in your **relay sign-up form** at check-in.
- Opening Ceremonies begin at 9:30 a.m. sharp. Ensure your group is checked in and ready by 9:30 a.m.

#### **SNACK/LUNCH:**

- A mid-morning snack (Rice Krispie bar and Capri Sun juice) will be available for students, chaperones, and bus drivers.
- Students, chaperones, and bus drivers must present the provided 'S' stickers from their registration packet to receive a snack.
- Please remind students to dispose of all trash in the appropriate containers.
- Lunch will not be provided. Schools should bring additional snacks and water if needed.

#### **MEDALS:**

- All Champion Games participants will receive medals, which will be distributed at the snack table <u>after</u> the relay races or just before you leave the event.
- Before loading the bus, please remember to grab your packet of medals.
- We encourage distributing the medals on the bus ride home to prevent them from being left at the event site.
- If leaving early, be sure to pick up medals before departure.

#### **MISCELLANEOUS:**

- Encourage students to dress appropriately for the weather (sunscreen, hats, jackets, etc.).
- Please use outdoor bathroom facilities unless a student requires a changing room, located inside the school.
  - If you need access to the changing room, ask for assistance at the snack table.
- If an item is lost, contact CESA 3 at (608) 822-3276 immediately following the event.

#### **CESA 3 Champion Games Relay Race Information**

To conclude the day's events, we will hold relay races. Each school district may organize up to two (2) relay teams, with each team consisting of eight (8) members.

- 1. Before arriving in Boscobel, complete the relay sign-up sheet with the names of students and/or chaperones participating. Relay sign-up sheets **must be turned in at check-in on May 9th.** No late teams will be accepted.
- 2. Listen for the announcement calling relay teams to the track. Look for your school's sign, line up your team(s), and remain seated until it is time to race. Each team must have chaperones to assist runners in getting to the appropriate lanes.
- 3. Students not participating in the relays are encouraged to cheer on their teams from the infield or bleachers. For safety reasons, the track must remain clear at all times.
- 4. Race format:
  - Each of the eight (8) runners per team will be positioned around the track at marked locations.
  - Runners will receive a colored card that matches their designated exchange point, marked by a colored flag.
  - The total race distance is 400 meters (one full lap around the track). Each runner will cover approximately 50 meters before passing the baton to the next runner.
  - Wheelchair participants are encouraged to participate with the option of assistance from another student or chaperone.
- 5. After completing the relay, teams should return to their designated school section outside the track.
